

# DIGIKUL – PROGRESS REPORT

Report Period: April 2025 to February 2026



## 1. Background & Activity Summary

**Digikul** is a computer training centre focused on providing **digital skills and career-oriented training to rural youth and school students**. The centre currently operates at **Dharhara and Vidyapeeth School**, where students are trained through a structured, practice-based learning model.

Digikul was established with the understanding that digital education in rural areas should go beyond basic computer knowledge. The objective is to ensure that students are not only trained in using computers, but are also able to **use their skills in real-life work situations**, leading towards employment or income enhancing opportunities.

## 2. Mission and Vision of Digikul

### Mission

During the early phase of training, one critical question emerged repeatedly: **“What happens after training is completed?”**

It was observed that subsequent to the training if the students do not get to use what they have learnt, they gradually forget their skills. Training by itself did not make sense for students from disadvantaged backgrounds. To address this, Digikul redefined its mission:

- To focus on skills that require **regular practice and real work tasks**
- To enable students to use these skills for **future income generation**
- To provide **job-based and usage-oriented training**

## Vision

Digikul aims to build a **practical skill ecosystem** where students can:

- Learn usable digital skills
- Apply them in real work scenarios
- Generate short-term or long-term income
- Move towards self-employment, jobs, or digital entrepreneurship

To achieve this vision, Digikul introduced training in:

- Online form filling (Caste, Income, Residence, Examination forms)
  - Graphic designing using Canva (posters, pamphlets, basic designs)
  - Video editing and content creation
  - Digital documentation and data handling

## 3. Future-Oriented Skill Outcomes

The skills taught at Digikul open multiple future pathways for students:

- Students trained in online form filling can generate **short-term income** by assisting people in their community
- Interested learners can move towards setting up their own **cyber service centres**
- Content creation training enables students to explore **YouTube, Facebook and other platforms** for digital income
- Over time, these skills can help students create **passive income sources** and sustainable livelihoods

In addition, with support from **Saral Services**, students also received **short-term paid work opportunities** such as video creation and data entry assignments.

## 4. Work Overview (April–Feb 2025)

During the reporting period, Digikul carried out the following key activities:

- Regular digital training batches
  - Work-based skill training modules
  - Short-term paid data entry work
  - Content creation assignments
  - Placement support and referrals to other organizations for training and jobs

## 5. Training Process

Digikul follows a **practice-driven and learner-focused training process**.

### Training Methodology:

- Each topic begins with a **5–10 minute live demonstration**
- The facilitator explains and performs the task step by step
- Students then receive **multiple practice assignments**

### Practice-Based Learning:

- If a student struggles with a concept, they are given **repetitive and varied practice tasks**
- For example, while learning folder creation:
  - Create folders using their own name
  - Use family members' names
  - Repeat the task multiple times

The next topic is introduced **only after the concept is clearly understood**.

### Differentiated Learning Approach:

- Fast learners receive advanced tasks
- They are encouraged to act as **class leaders**
- This promotes **peer learning**, while also ensures that the slower learners are also helped to learn

This approach results in:

1. Stronger conceptual clarity for fast learners
2. Peer-supported learning for slower learners

3. Balanced workload for facilitators

### **Feedback and Assessment:**

- Daily 5-minute feedback sessions
  - Weekly review and Saturday analysis classes
  - Periodic tests and one-to-one feedback
- 

## **6. Support System**

Digikul receives support from multiple stakeholders:

- Funding agencies support infrastructure and recurring expenses
- School administration provide space and coordination
- Local community leaders who understand and support the vision
- Students who support each other through peer to peer learning
- Saral Services team who continuously guide and strengthen the program

## **8. Process Followed**

### **a. Mobilization:**

- Outreach within a 5 km radius of training centres
- Direct interaction with youth and parents
- Explaining of the importance of digital education to the community
- Distribution of Pamphlets and invitation for demonstration class

Mobilization team structure:

- one female mobilizer (girls and young women)
- two male mobilizers (parents, elders, male youth)

### **Training Structure:**

- Total training duration: **3 months**
- Daily class duration: **2 hours**

Class structure:

- 15 minutes: practice of previous day's lessons
- 15 minutes: explanation of new topic
- 1.5 hours: self-practice and assignments
